1. International activities

- 1.1. The goal to establish new international contacts was reached at the European Conference which was held in May in Syros, Greece. Slovakia was represented by Ing. Katarina Koledova who also participated in the OMEP Executive Committee Meeting which followed the European Conference.
- 1.2. Development of new international contact was also reached during the presentation of Wattsenglish language school from Liberec, Czech Republic in April. The presentation was held by Marek Kadlec who is an OMEP representative for the Czech Republic abroad and by Steve Watts who is the founder of Wattsenglish method. It was highly appreciated by all members and it should be followed by a visit to Liberec kindergartens. Although the 2-day visit was logistically prepared, it was not carried out and therefore postponed to 2012.

2. Activities aimed at improvement of educational activities in kindergarten.

- 2.1. Our members attended a joined meeting with their partners from the Czech Republic where they gained new knowledge about international educational methodology.
- 2.2. Our members also attended various expert seminars which were focused on methodology and were organized in cooperation with the methodological centre or founders.
- 2.3. Throughout the year, individual members maintained working relationships by the means of personal meetings, experience exchange and consulting.

3. Management improvement activities

To acquire this goal, our managers attended various conferences, seminars and lectures and personal meetings throughout the year. They deepened their knowledge in this area and they applied it in day-to-day work.
